It will not have escaped anyone's notice how unusually hot the weather was last week and therefore safeguarding the children, as always, was our priority. We believe we took all reasonable measures to ensure the children's day was adjusted to ensure they could stay as cool and hydrated as possible, and physical activity was done before 10:00am when temperatures were not above unacceptable limits. For one outdoor activity, the children were under gazebos with their water bottles for a short amount of time and lunches were re-planned so that children were able to stay in the air-conditioned hall during mid-day. Heatwave guidance was followed at all times. However, it was frustrating and unfair to hear, that on Facebook there were comments from a minority of parents stating that Hillside did not manage the heat well. What is more frustrating, is that these parents did not come to ask what precautions had been taken, therefore the information posted was inaccurate. Hillside works very hard to ensure the safety of every pupil and I consider myself, the teachers and Leadership Team to be very approachable if there are any causes for concern. I would request, that posts on Facebook in the future are posted with accuracy so as not to cause unnecessary alarm to parents. I understand that Facebook is a preferred method of communication for some parents, but I am sure you can appreciate the only way we can address concerns is if we know about them, and finding out through Facebook, is not the right channel.

On a happier note, and on behalf of all the staff at Hillside, as it is the end of Ramadam, we hope you all enjoyed your celebrations.
